

TWIN VALLEY RIDERS CLUB POLICY
REGULATING THE GUIDELINES FOR AWARDS

I. **RIBBONS**

A. Lead line

1. Ribbons will say “Twin Valley Riders Club Lead Line All-Stars”.
2. Ribbons will be a different color for each of the five events.

B. Children

1. Ribbons will be awarded six placings: blue for 1st, red for 2nd, yellow for 3rd, white for 4th, pink for 5th, and green for 6th.
2. Those riding and not receiving a placing shall receive a green participant ribbon.

C. Youth

1. Ribbons will be awarded six placings: blue for 1st, red for 2nd, yellow for 3rd, white for 4th, pink for 5th, and green for 6th.
2. Do not write on the ribbons in case some of the older kids do not want their placing.

II. **YEAR-END AWARDS**

A. Lead line – will receive small trophies

1. To be eligible for the year-end trophy you must ride in at least two shows.

B. Children – Youth – Adult – Senior – Jack Benny Classes

1. Buckles will be awarded for Champion and Reserve Hi Point individuals in each of the above classes.
 - a. Children’s: Small Buckle – suggested sizes 2 ½ X 3 ½ or 3 ½ X 2 ¾
 - b. Youth: Medium Buckle – suggested sizes 3 X 4 or 3 ¼ X 4 ¼
 - c. Adult: Medium/Large Buckle – suggested sizes 3 ¾ X 4 ¼, 4 X 4 ¾, 3 ¾ X 5 or 4 X 5

(check the Montana Silversmith website www.montanasilversmith.com for sizes)

III. **COST**

- A. Cost of the buckle awards will follow the club guidelines in the minutes of the club.

IV. **PURCHASING**

- A. An attempt should be made to find the best price for buckles. Reichert’s Saddlery, 24136 1st St., Leonard, MN, 218-968-2248, 1-800-816-1619 (toll free), or 218-968-2202 (fax) has sold them to the club for 10% over cost for many years. Unless they change their sale policy, we should place our buckle orders through them. Request their current buckle catalog after the August “Fun Days”.
