

# WEATHER POLICY

In the case of heat, where the temperature should be 90 degrees or more, a decision on whether to have the show or not, if at all possible, should be made by 8:00 p.m. Friday evening prior to the show.

In the event of heavy or ongoing rains or severe weather activity a decision for postponement should be made by 7:30 a.m. Sunday morning, or earlier, if at all possible. The local directors are responsible for going to the arena and making recommendations on the facilities conditions to the President. With the information provided to the President on weather and arena conditions, it is the responsibility of the TVRC President to make the call on the show based on the information he was given by the directors.

If the show is postponed due to inclement weather (rain or heat) the "Fun Days" will be held the following Saturday and if it cannot be held on the following Saturday, it will be rescheduled for the third Sunday in September.

This date could be adjusted to a date set by the Twin Valley Riders Club Executive Board of Directors or if a TVRC meeting is scheduled in the near future, by a date agreed upon by the majority of the members present at this meeting.
